Public Statement from Veteran Warriors Executive Director

November 7, 2022

As we near Veterans Day, Veteran Warriors recommits to clarifying topic awareness in the Veteran Community in our social media channels. Caregiver Support seems to be at the center of the many topics of concern within the Veteran community; we understand your frustration and hear you. Veteran Warriors will continue to advocate for the widely expressed changes within the program for the best interest of this community, and we are grateful the Department of Veterans Affairs is open to change. We deeply appreciate the positive culture shift in caregiver outlook within the community. We have publicly acknowledged and applauded as the program reflects the extensive listening sessions. We are proud of the progress made and the bold actions taken in court that have already helped many in the Caregiver community with the Supervision, Protection, and Instruction clause.
